Hebrews 2:11-18

What is special about having a sibling? What might be frustrating?

How have we become members of God's family?

Philip was willing to stand up for his sister when a classmate made fun of her. Against whom was Jesus willing to fight for us?

How far was he willing to go?

How does God call us to treat our siblings? Family members? Fellow believers?

How did Jesus demonstrate that he was concerned with helping us?

Jesus promised to take care of everything for us with **“atonement for the sins of the people.”** What does “atonement” mean?

List at least 2 ways Jesus has experienced the same problems we have.
